
MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT/CEO

Visitors who explored community focused cultural celebrations through 5 different art exhibitions. Our Art Center Team provided programming to nearly 3,800 children. Hours of counseling and service coordination delivered in English and Spanish to 855 people facing behavorial health, family violence, and substance abuse challenges.

Mattie Rhodes Center utilizes a family-focused, strength based model of therapeutic and social services in providing support, guidance, and tools to address personal needs and difficult circumstances.

Nuevo Dia and Otro Camino programs offer a range of services such as counseling, service coordination, legal support, and child-focused therapy for survivors of intimate partner violence and their children; as well as groups and counseling for batterers.

The Nuevo Amanecer program provides individual and group treatment for persons struggling with substance abuse challenges and their families to increase the level of overall functioning and wellbeing of participants.
